

LOGT 3232 Project Update Requirements

Due: 9/25 at the start of class

Purpose: To ensure groups get formed and get a head start in planning their projects.
Provide me with company choices to help you select a good 3PL.

Requirements:

- 1) Typed list of the four or five group members;
- 2) List of three possible companies in order of preference;
- 3) Copy of project guidelines (for group and not to be turned in);
- 4) Outline of slide presentation; and,
- 5) List of who is responsible for which portions of the presentation.

General Notes:

Your group will prepare a 15 minute presentation in PowerPoint. There is not a written paper with this project. Your grade is based on the turned in presentation and not any in-class talk!!! So, it needs to be clear with the turned version. There will not be any “clarifying” later.

Also, there will be a peer evaluation conducted after the group project is completed. Please consider your and your group member actions as you work through this project. I reserve the right to increase or decrease individual scores by ANY AMOUNT based on the peer evaluations!!!! So, every member of the team needs to contribute. I will post the peer evaluation forms on the website shortly.

Simple Hints:

You are looking for a Third Part Logistics (3PL) company that provides sufficient information for you to complete the presentation. Therefore, I would not choose “Bubba’s Logistics.” Also, there are a number of companies listed in the section and in the book that covers 3PL.

If you are unsure if your slides are presenting enough info, remember that it has to stand on its own (i.e., you can not verbally add any info later.)

Do not complete this project until your company is APPROVED!!! I will not allow more than two groups to do the same company. Also, I will not allow some companies because they are not “good” choices. This means that they are not 3PLs or will be very difficult to gather info (subsidiaries or private firms).
